

# BORGO ANTICO

APERITIVI PASTA VINI

## BOLLE

- LA MARCA PROSECCO (VENETO, ITALIA)** 375ml 28  
The liquid sparkles with lively bubbles offering aromas of citrus and honeysuckle blossoms. The palate is crisp and clean showing notes of green apple, juicy peach and ripe lemon, framed by hints of minerality and a touch of sweetness.
- MASOTTINA 96 COLLECTION PROSECCO (VENETO, ITALIA)** 6oz 13 46  
Prosecco - for the unmistakable Made in Italy lifestyle! Versatile and fresh with balanced acidity and a light touch of sweetness. Enjoy aromas of pear and stone fruit with flavours of green apple offering a crisp, clean finish.
- BRILLA! PROSECCO ROSÉ (VENETO, ITALIA)** 48  
From Veneto's wine region, Brilla Rosé Prosecco is so pretty in the glass. Pale pink and elegant on the nose with a lively and persistent mousse of ripe cherry, red berry, lemon-lime zest notes. The bubbles will dance in your mouth!

## BIANCO

- OXFORD LANDING CHARDONNAY 2021 (SOUTH AUSTRALIA)** 6oz 11 9oz 16 42  
The grapes in this wine are sourced from vineyards in South Australia, where the winemaking focuses on minimal intervention, using wild yeasts, malolactic fermentation, lees contact and subtle oak to give this Chardonnay depth, complexity and personality. Aromas of stone fruit, wild honey and cinnamon spice on the nose. A slight hint of oak comes through on the palate highlighting the cinnamon and spice.
- CIÙ CIÙ ORIS 2023 (MARCHE, ITALIA)** 6oz 12 9oz 17 44  
This white blend is fresh with balanced acidity. The nose has aromas of blossom and spice and the palate has tropical fruit flavours. The Ciù Ciù winery is located in the heart of the Piceno wine region, situated between the foothills of the central Appenine mountains and the Adriatic Sea. It is in this DOC of Falerio, where this micro climate helps the Pecorino, Passerina and Trebbiano grapes flourish.
- TWIN ISLANDS SAUVIGNON BLANC 2022 (MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND)** 6oz 12 9oz 17 44  
This Sauvignon Blanc is refreshingly crisp, ranging from tropical to zesty, packed with citrus and fresh herbs. When Marlborough started planting Sauvignon Blanc grapes in the late 1970s, they did not anticipate the grape's stratospheric popularity. Accounting for only 1% of the world's wine production - NZ was the world's 6th largest wine exporter in 2022.
- KRIS PINOT GRIGIO 2021 (VENETO, ITALIA)** 6oz 14 9oz 20 50  
KRIS' beautifully designed labels are steeped in intrigue. The gold orb in each label depicts the role of the Italian sun ripening the grapes to perfection. The alluring kiss mark represents the role of the lips that ultimately savor the wine. The hand represents the role of the human hand in cultivating the grapes and crafting the wine. In the bottle, the enticing aromas are of acacia flowers, citrus fruit and a hint of apricot. KRIS Pinot Grigio is bold and refreshing, offering a long finish with a hint of orange blossom and honey.
- REGALEALI BIANCO (SICILIA, ITALIA)** 50  
Grown and produced in Sicily, this white blend is sweetly-scented and remarkably pretty with unexpected depth. The nose has scents of white flowers, ripe peaches, candied citrus and hints of wet stone. The palate balances zesty acidity and salty minerals for a pleasant balance of sweet and sour, keeping the expression wildly fresh.
- LADOGANA TERRE DI SALDE GRECO DI TUFO 2022 (PUGLIA, ITALIA)** 54  
Terre di Salde or "Firm Lands", means not tilled by the plough. This white greco is soft and round with floral aromas and hints of stone fruit. The grape flourishes in volcanic soil which brings out its aromatic flavours.

## ROSATO

- MALIVOIRE LADYBUG ROSÉ (NIAGARA PENINSULA, ONTARIO)** 6oz 11 9oz 16 42  
Director turned wine grower, Martin Malivoire operates Malivoire Wine on the commitment to sustainability. His was the first winery on the Beamsville Bench in Niagara to be a gravity-flow winery. With use of its elevation, Malivoire allows the slope to direct the grapes during the wine making process, eliminating the use of a pump. The Ladybug is a star with its brightly scented strawberry, raspberry and crab apple aromas. The palate bursts with candy apple, pomegranate and a cherry-tinged finish.
- PASQUA 11 MINUTES ROSÉ 2022 (VENETO, ITALIA)** 60  
The name 11 MINUTES refers to the duration of the skin contact, creating its beautiful rosy shade of pink. This rosé is a blend of the most noble native varieties; Corvina, Trebbiano di Lugana, Syrah and Carménère. Reminiscent of a summer evening, the nose is raspberry, grapefruit and dried-herb notes. It is juicy with a medium body, finishing with generous watermelon, grapefruit and a dash of spice.

## ROSSO

- FARMERS OF WINE PRIMITIVO NEGROAMARO 2022 (PUGLIA, ITALIA)** 6oz 11 9oz 16 42  
The Farmers' employ the Abarello method of wine growing where the vines are bush trained vines and pruned low to the ground offering a unique canopy protection from wind. They pass the discipline on through apprenticeship to engage stewardship, community, culture and tradition. This organic wine has a nose of dark ripe plum and cherry. The palate has the same juicy flavours balanced with chocolate, spice and finishing with subtle tannins.
- MASI FRESCARIPA BARDOLINO CLASSICO 2020 (VERONA, ITALIA)** 6oz 12 9oz 17 44  
Classic in a contemporary style, made with the 3 grapes of the Veneto region; Corvina, Rondinella, Molinara. Fresh aromas of plum, cherry and peppered spice. The palate is full-bodied with cherry and blackcurrant flavours, good supporting acidity and smooth tannins.
- TENUTA REGALEALI NERO D'AVOLA 2021 (SICILIA, ITALIA)** 6oz 13 9oz 18 45  
A crowd-pleaser that is juicy and delicious. It has a bright ruby-red colour offering layered aromas of cherry, mulberry and raspberry. The palate is fresh and savory, doling out Morello cherry, raspberry and star anise, finishing with smooth and silky tannins.
- MALIVOIRE FARMSTEAD GAMAY 2021 (NIAGARA PENINSULA, ONTARIO)** 6oz 14 9oz 20 52  
This Gamay offers a nose that is fragrant and gentle with cherry, raspberry and potpourri. The complexity expands on the palate with a burst of cherry, red berry and a zesty spice. In the Beaujolais region of France, the Gamay grape is king. Here in Canada, it vies for a spot among the other cool climate grapes that thrive in the Niagara Region. The grapes grown in the Niagara Peninsula account for 80% of Canada's grape-growing volume.
- TENUTA MORAIA IL PACCHIA MAREMMA 2020 (TOSCANA, ITALIA)** 6oz 18 9oz 24 62  
The nose is inviting with dark berry fruits, cherry and plum, while the palate satisfies with structured intensity and a balance of fruit and spice. This Tuscan blend is named for the Renaissance painter, Girolamo del Pacchia, whose art graces the Oratory of the San Bernardino Church in Siena, Italy.
- CANTINA SETTECANI LAMBRUSCO GRASPAROSSA SECCO DOP ORGANIC (EMILIA ROMAGNA, ITALIA)** 52  
Vibrant flavors of wild cherry, blackberry, and a touch of violet in this organic Lambrusco. Its medium-bodied structure and crisp, dry finish provide a lively and quenching sensation, making it an ideal companion for hearty Italian fare.
- LADOGANA GHORT NERO DI TROIA 2020 (PUGLIA, ITALIA)** 52  
This single varietal wine blends fruit and spice with a powerful body to provide an excellent compliment to your culinary experience. Grown primarily in Puglia, Nero de Troia vies for prominence among the other local grapes - Primitivo and Negroamaro. It continues to gain ground, producing excellent wines.
- ABEL MENDOZA JARRARTE 2022 (RIOJA, SPAIN)** 55  
This Tempranillo offers a fruity and floral nose with notes of violet, cherry and currant. The palate is full of red fruit, fresh and balanced with well-integrated acidity. Abel Mendoza is a small winery that selects only a few international markets to ship their wine and Winnipeg is one lucky recipient of a small allocation of these sought-after wines. The wine makers take whole clusters of grapes to ferment on their stems in concrete vats. This unique technique produces fresh and fruity wines that are ready to drink young!
- PASQUA VALPOLICELLA RIPASSO SUPERIORE 2020 (VENETO, ITALIA)** 66  
Baby brother to the Amarone, this Valpolicella's complexity is enhanced when it is "passed over" the grapes of its big brother, Amarone, where it undergoes a secondary fermentation. This process dates back to the feudal system when everything was employed (and reused) to its fullest capacity. Once secondary fermentation is complete, the wine is aged for a specific number of months in oak barriques to acquire the Superiore status. Full-bodied, offering cherry, soft plum and vanilla on the palate, finishing with smooth tannins.
- TENUTA REGALEALI CYGNUS BLEND (SICILIA, ITALIA)** 86  
Tenuta Regaleali is an eighth generation Sicilian winery with a vineyard oasis in the center of the island that produces incredibly rich, deep, reds. Cygnus blends the local Nero d'Avola grape with the famous Cabernet Sauvignon for a wine with dark fruit and balsamic and vanilla notes.
- DIEVOLE PETRIGNANO CHIANTI CLASSICO 2019 (CHIANTI, ITALIA)** 95  
This wine is the soul of Dievole's Chianti Classico terroir. Coming from vineyards on exposed limestone hillsides, it's a pure expression of Sangiovese with opulent ripe blackberry fruit, fine tannins, and a warm smooth finish.
- THE PRISONER RED BLEND 2021 (CALIFORNIA)** 118  
A powerhouse of California red wine, The Prisoner is a Zinfandel based blend with dark rich chocolate notes and toasty warm oak spice. This is a luscious, full bodied, red blend that was inspired by the wines of mixed black grapes made by Italian and Portuguese immigrants in the early days of Californian winegrowing.
- DENIS DURANTOU CHÂTEAU LES CRUZELLES LANDE DE POMEROL 2018 (BORDEAUX, FRANCE)** 140  
The wine displays a warm core of red and black plum with a slightly stewed fruit character, baking spice and subtle oak. It is bold and bright with structured tannins and balanced acidity. Château Les Cruzelles is a 10.5 acre property located in the commune of Néac within the small appellation of Lelande-de-Pomerol. It is on Bordeaux's right bank where the blends are predominantly Merlot and Cabernet Franc. The water ways are of great importance in this part of Bordeaux. They help define the appellation's boundaries, moderate the climate and are instrumental in the make-up of the terroir.
