

BOLLE

LA MARCA PROSECCO (VENETO, ITALIA)

375ml The liquid sparkles with lively bubbles offering aromas of citrus and honeysuckle blossoms. The palate is crisp and clean showing notes of green apple, juicy peach and ripe lemon, framed by hints of minerality and a touch of sweetness.

SPUMANTE RIBOLLA GIALLA BRUT SAN MARTINO (FRIULI-VENEZIA GIULIA, ITALIA) This Italian sparkler showcases the bright, zesty character of Ribolla Gialla with aromas of lemon blossom, green apple, and pear, layered with hints of almond and wet stone. The palate is crisp and dry, featuring fine, persistent bubbles and a refreshing citrus-driven acidity. The finish is clean, with subtle herbal and mineral nuances.

BRILLA! PROSECCO ROSÉ 2023 (VENETO, ITALIA)

From Veneto's wine region, Brilla Rosé Prosecco is so pretty in the glass. Pale pink and elegant on the nose with a lively and persistent mousse of ripe cherry, red berry, lemon-lime zest notes. The bubbles will dance in your mouth!

CANTINA SETTECANI LAMBRUSCO GRASPAROSSA SECCO DOP ORGANIC (EMILIA ROMAGNA,

Vibrant flavors of wild cherry, blackberry, and a touch of violet in this organic Lambrusco. Its medium-bodied structure and crisp, dry finish provide a lively and quenching sensation, making it an ideal companion for hearty Italian fare.

BIANCO

TWIN ISLANDS SAUVIGNON BLANC 2024 (MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND)

This Sauvignon Blanc is refreshingly crisp, ranging from tropical to zesty, packed with citrus and fresh herbs. When Marlborough started planting Sauvignon Blanc grapes in the late 1970s, they did not anticipate the grape's stratospheric popularity. Accounting for only 1% of the world's wine production

CIÙ CIÙ ORIS 2023 (MARCHE, ITALIA)

This white blend is fresh with balanced acidity. The nose has aromas of blossom and spice and the palate has tropical fruit flavours. The Ciù Ciù winery is located in the heart of the Piceno wine region, situated between the foothills of the central Appenine mountains and the Adriatic Sea. It is in this DOC of Falerio, where this micro climate helps the Pecorino, Passerina and Trebbiano grapes flourish.

KRIS PINOT GRIGIO 2024 (VENETO, ITALIA)

KRIS' beautifully designed labels are steeped in intrigue. The gold orb in each label depicts the role of the Italian sun ripening the grapes to perfection. The alluring kiss mark represents the role of the lips that ultimately savor the wine. The hand represents the role of the human hand in cultivating the grapes and crafting the wine. In the bottle, the enticing aromas are of acacia flowers, citrus fruit and a hint of apricot. KRIS Pinot Grigio is bold and refreshing, offering a long finish with a hint of orange blossom and honey.

CASALE DEL GIGLIO BELLONE 2023 (LAZIO, ITALIA)

- NZ was the world's 6th largest wine exporter in 2022.

The persistent coastal sea breezes contribute to the Bellone's pronounced minerality. Rich and ample with floral and tropical notes, finishing with a hint of spice and a zesty tang.

REGALEALI BIANCO 2022 (SICILIA, ITALIA)

Grown and produced in Sicily, this white blend is sweetly-scented and remarkably pretty with unexpected depth. The nose has scents of white flowers, ripe peaches, candied citrus and hints of wet stone. The palate balances zesty acidity and salty minerals for a pleasant balance of sweet and sour, keeping the expression wildly fresh.

LADOGANA TERRE DI SALDE GRECO DI TUFO 2022 (PUGLIA, ITALIA)

Terre di Salde or "Firm Lands", means not tilled by the plough. This white greco is soft and round with floral aromas and hints of stone fruit. The grape flourishes in volcanic soil which brings out its

BRUNA GRIMALDI LANGHE ARNEIS 2023 (PIEMONTE, ITALIA)

The Arneis, once named "White Barolo" grape has a long history in Piedmont, where documents testify its presence as far back as the 1200s. This Arneis offers aromas and flavours of white flowers, bursts of tropical fruit and finishes with a soft creaminess.

MALIVOIRE LADYBUG ROSÉ 2023 (NIAGARA PENINSULA, ONTARIO) Director turned wine grower, Martin Malivoire operates Malivoire Wine on the commitment to

sustainability. His was the first winery on the Beamsville Bench in Niagara to be a gravity-flow winery. With use of its elevation, Malivoire allows the slope to direct the grapes during the wine making process, eliminating the use of a pump. The Ladybug is a star with its brightly scented strawberry, raspberry and crab apple aromas. The palate bursts with candy apple, pomegranate and

DI GIOVANNA 'VURRIA' ROSATO NERELLO MASCALESE 2024 (SICILIA, ITALIA)

Di Giovanna is one of the oldest wine growing families in Sicily and dates back 5 generations. Vurria Rosato was first made in 2004 in the family cellar from 100% Nerello Mascalese grapes and continues to be vinified in steel. The nose expresses a floral bouquet of pomegranate, citrus fruits and aromatic herbs. On the palate it is fresh, harmonious and persistent with a distinct minerality and a savoury finish. The wine takes its name from a Sicilian poem Vurria, meaning to wish or to long for...perhaps another glass of rosé?

ROSSO

MASI FRESCARIPA BARDOLINO CLASSICO 2022 (VERONA, ITALIA)

6oz 12 9oz 17

Classic in a contemporary style, made with the 3 grapes of the Veneto region; Corvina, Rondinella, Molinara. Fresh aromas of plum, cherry and peppered spice. The palate is full-bodied with cherry and blackcurrant flavours, good supporting acidity and smooth tannins.

FARMERS OF WINE PRIMITIVO NEGROAMARO 2023 (PUGLIA, ITALIA)

The Farmers' employ the Abarello method of wine growing where the vines are bush trained vines and pruned low to the ground offering a unique canopy protection from wind. They pass the discipline on through apprenticeship to engage stewardship, community, culture and tradition. This organic wine has a nose of dark ripe plum and cherry. The palate has the same juicy flavours balanced with chocolate, spice and finishing with subtle tannins.

TENUTA REGALEALI NERO D'AVOLA 2022 (SICILIA, ITALIA)

A crowd-pleaser that is juicy and delicious. It has a bright ruby-red colour offering layered aromas of cherry, mulberry and raspberry. The palate is fresh and savory, doling out Morello cherry, raspberry and star anise, finishing with smooth and silky tannins.

CASALE DEL GIGLIO CESANESE 2022 (LAZIO, ITALIA)

6oz 17 9oz 23

Cesanese is a low yield, late ripening varietal which often guarantees a long lasting wine. Intense aromas of marasca cherry, violet with white and black pepper spice. The palate offers a softness, balanced by bright acidity and persistent tannins.

TENUTA MORAIA IL PACCHIA MAREMMA 2022 (TOSCANA, ITALIA)

The nose is inviting with dark berry fruits, cherry and plum, while the palate satisfies with structured intensity and a balance of fruit and spice. This Tuscan blend is named for the Renaissance painter, Girolamo del Pacchia, whose art graces the Oratory of the San Bernardino Church in Siena, Italy.

ABEL MENDOZA JARRARTE 2024 (RIOJA, SPAIN)

This Tempranillo offers a fruity and floral nose with notes of violet, cherry and currant. The palate is full of red fruit, fresh and balanced with well-integrated acidity. Abel Mendoza is a small winery that selects only a few international markets to ship their wine and Winnipeg is one lucky recipient of a small allocation of these sought-after wines. The wine makers take whole clusters of grapes to ferment on their stems in concrete vats. This unique technique produces fresh and fruity wines that are ready to drink young!

DOMAINE CÉCILE PAQUET BOURGOGNE PINOT NOIR 2023 (BURGUNDY, FRANCE)

Certified organic and practicing biodynamic, the grapes for this producer's wines are grown on a 1.5 hectare plot, achieving maximum expression of the terroir. Cécile Paquet's Pinot Noir has a rich nose, full of cherries and raspberries. The palate is well-balanced, yet complex, with notes of Amarena cherry and licorice.

TENUTA REGALEALI CYGNUS BLEND 2021 (SICILIA, ITALIA)

Tenuta Regaleali is an eighth generation Sicilian winery with a vineyard oasis in the center of the island that produces incredibly rich, deep, reds. Cygnus blends the local Nero d'Avola grape with the famous Cabernet Sauvignon for a wine with dark fruit and balsamic and vanilla notes.

SANTA SOFIA VALPOLICELLA RIPASSO SUPERIORE 2022 (VENETO, ITALIA)

Santa Sofia's first cellar was built in 1300 by the friars of San Bernardino in the Valpoicella region of Italy. The cellar was first expanded in 1565 when the Villa was built and further additions in 1811, when the winery was founded. This region is famous for it's big, bold Amarones. The Ripasso is considered its little brother, even borrowing the Amarone's dried grapes during fermentation. These partially dried grapes add depth and complexity to the wine. This Ripasso Superiore offers a powerful nose and a concentrated palate. You will discover dark cherry, prune and baking spice with a long and silky finish.

BRUNA GRIMALDI SCASSA BARBERA D'ALBA 2022 (PIEMONTE, ITALIA)

The Italian word scassare means "to break" and this wine is named for the difficulties of ripping up the land to prepare for growing the grape vines. You will find Scassa full of red fruits, sour cherry, graphite and menthol notes on the nose with a rich palate and fresh minerality.

TOLAINI VALDISANTI 2021 (TOSCANA, ITALIA)

The grapes are grown in southern Tuscany, blending 50% Cabernet Sauvignon and 50% Cabernet Franc. Its nose is youthful with rich dark fruit, berry and cassis aromas . The palate is full and deep with reserved fruit flavors framed by rich oak.

DENIS DURANTOU CHÂTEAU LES CRUZELLES LALANDE DE POMEROL 2019 (BORDEAUX, FRANCE) The wine displays a warm core of red and black plum with a slightly stewed fruit character, baking spice and subtle oak. It is bold and bright with structured tannins and balanced acidity. Château Les Cruzelles is a 10.5 acre property located in the commune of Néac within the small appellation of Lelande-de-Pomerol. It is on Bordeaux's right bank where the blends are predominantly Merlot and Cabernet Franc. The water ways are of great importance in this part of Bordeaux. They help define the appellation's boundaries, moderate the climate and are instrumental in the make-up of the terroir.

BRUNA GRIMALDI CAMILLA BAROLO 2021 (PIEMONTE, ITALIA)

Elegant and beautiful, this 100% Nebbiolo Barolo has a delightful nose with floral notes and spice. The palate has a harmonious blend of cherry, raspberry and herbs, finishing with fine tannins.
